NRA SAFETY RULES

- . ALWAYS TREAT EVERY FIREARM AS IF IT WERE LOADED.
- . ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FIREARM UNLOADED UNTIL YOUR READY TO USE IT.
- . ALWAYS POINT YOUR FIREARM IN A SAFE DIRECTION. ALWAYS POINT YOUR FIREARM DOWN RANGE.
 - NEVER POINT YOUR FIREARM AT ANYTHING YOU DON'T INTEND TO SHOOT.
 - ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOUR READY TO SHOOT.
 - ALWAYS BE SURE OF YOUR TARGET AND WHAT'S BEYOND IT.

GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- 1. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS MANDATORY FOR EVERYONE IN THE RANGE.
- 2. LEADWASH YOUR HANDS AFTER RANGE USE
- 3. NEVER MIX ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WITH FIREARMS.
- 4. IF RED LIGHTS FLASHING SET DOWN YOUR FIREARM POINTING DOWN RANGE STEP BEHIND GRAY LINE
- 5. ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FIREARMS POINTED DOWN RANGE. THE FIREARM SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE BOOTH UNLESS IT IS PROPERLY SECURED FOR TRAVEL. NEVER POINT THE BARREL OF YOUR FIREARM AROUND OR BRING IT TO ANOTHER BOOTH
- 6. PLACE DUDS IN ORANGE TUBE
- 7. ALWAYS STAY ALERT AROUND THE RANGE AREA AFTER SHOOTING SECURE YOUR FIREARM IN THE RANGE BAG
- 8. NO SMOKING!
- 9. NO PETS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED IN THE RANGE.
- 10. ALL SHOOTERS MUST STAY BEHIND AND MUST HAVE THEIR MUZZLE OVER THE FIRING LINE WHEN SHOOTING.
- 11. NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED
- 12. NO CELL USE DURING ACTIVE RANGE FIRING

GENERAL SAFETY PROCEDURES

ALWAYS CALL OUT "CEASE FIRE" AND VISUALLY ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU WERE HEARD.

ALWAYS MAKE SURE ALL FIREARMS ARE UNLOADED AND MADE SAFE WITH FIREARMS PLACED WITH THE ACTION OPEN AND UP SITTING ON THE BENCH OR TABLE FACING DOWN RANGE.

CHAMBER SAFETY FLAGS ARE SUGGESTED.

FIREARMS ARE NEVER TO BE TOUCHED OR HANDLED FOR ANY REASON WHILE SOMEONE IS DOWN RANGE.

REMEMBER

- 1.TAKE FIRE ARMS AND AMMUNITION OUT OF THE RANGE BAGS AND SET ON TABLE PONING DOWN RANGE YOU CAN THEN PLACE THE BAGS BEHIND YOU ON THE FLOOR DO NOT BLOCK AIR WALL
- 2. BEFORE YOU DO ANY SHOOTING, MOVE THE TARGET TO THE DISTANCE YOU ARE SHOOTING AND MAKE CERTAIN THAT THE TARGET IS LINED UP SO THAT ALL BULLETS IMPACT THE WATERFALL MAKE THIS ADJUSTMENT ANYTIME YOU CHANGE DISTANCES
- 3. ALWAYS CHECK THE DOWN RANGE AREA IS CLEAR BEFORE SHOOTING.
- 4.PAPER TARGETS MUST BE CENTERED AND ATTACHED TO THE TARGET FRAMES PROVIDED. THIS ENSURES ALL BULLETS HIT THE CENTER OF THE WATERFALL SNAIL UNIT
- 5. NO METAL NO CARDBOARD
- ONLY USE PROVIDED BACKING STOCK
- 6. ALWAYS MAKE SURE OF PROPER TARGET ALIGNMENT TO THE EXISTING WATERFALL
- 7. ONLY NORMAL HANDGUN ROUNDS AND RIFLE ROUNDS ARE ALLOWED SEE POSTED CHART
- 8. SHOTGUN, TRACER, INCENDIARY, AND ARMOR PIERCING ROUNDS, BLACK POWDER RIFLES ARE PROHIBITED!
- 9. TRASH AND BRASS, ALUMINUM, STEEL GOES IN THE PROPER RECEPTICALS OR YOU BRING IT HOME, LEAVE NO TRACE!
- 10. AUTOMATIC GUN FIRE IS PROHIBITED MUST HAVE PROPER LICENSE. CONTACT RSO
- 11. QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE INDOOR RANGE COMMITTEE.
- 12. DO NOT CLEAN YOUR GUNS IN THE RANGE TAKE THEM HOME TO CLEAN
- 13. CLEAN UP TRASH SWEEP FLOOR TURN OFF THE RANGE / ALL LIGHTS AND ARM THE SYSTEM WHEN YOU LEAVE
